Dear Mr. Judkins,

The Department has determined that the American Lamp Recycling facility process associated with mercury containing lamps, used electronics, small capacitor PCB ballasts, non-PCB ballasts, batteries and other mercury containing devices is not applicable under the 6NYCRR Part 360 (solid waste) regulations as the material is covered under the Part 373 (hazardous waste) regulations. Therefore, the Part 360 registration submitted for the 55 Riverview Drive, Marlboro, Ulster County facility is not necessary. Similarly, the Part 360 registration for the 26 Industrial Way, Wappingers Falls, Dutchess County facility may be withdrawn by American Lamp Recycling.

It is my understanding that the facility is exempt from hazardous waste permitting under the recycling exemption found at 373-1.1(d)(1)(viii) as long as storage requirements are met.
